

Field Technician/ Field Support

Minnow Environmental Inc. (Trinity Consultants' Aquatic Environmental Services), is a leader in Aquatic Environmental Consulting services and conducts studies in freshwater and marine environments across Canada. We have been retained by IAMGOLD to conduct fish salvage work at the Côté Gold site and are looking for field technicians to support the project. The position will involve fish capture, relocation, collection of fish measurements, note taking, and water quality monitoring. The project will run from early May to late September. Technicians will work full time. The position will involve working outside (even in inclement weather) and on/in water. Training will be provided to the successful candidates on the following skills:

- fish collections and measurements,
- field measurements using a multi-meter probe and calibration of the probe, and
- health and safety protocols and procedures including WHIMIS and first aid certification.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be provided, but CSA protective boots will need to be provided by successful applicants. The successful candidate will be interested in learning environmental sampling techniques, is fit and capable of the physical demands of working outside and working around water, is capable of lifting and working with heavy loads and work well in a team environment. A valid driver's license is an asset.

Year Two of the fish salvage will commence in early May 2021 and proceed until the late fall. Year Three will continue in 2022 (anticipated start date mid-June) and Minnow will be looking to rehire as many staff members as possible.
