Work Schedule: Rotation consisting of 14 days in and 14 days out- 10 hour shift daily.

Responsibilities

- Operate and maintain the wastewater and potable treatment plant
- Collect samples for in house and laboratory analysis
- Monitor the process and make adjustments as required
- Ensure the water quality meets the standards as per the permit effluent and potable water
- Running the equipment and ensuring to complete proper field checks
- Ensure to keep and file required documentation

Education/ Qualification

- Must be an **Ontario Certified Wastewater Operator (Class 2)**
- Must be an **Ontario Certified Drinking Water Operator (Class 1 or limited surface water)**
- Minimum 2 years of experience as a Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator
- Experience with MBR and nanofiltration plants would be an asset
- Excellent communication skills required
- Ability to work well independently and as a team member

Other Requirements

- G Class Driver's license with clean driving record (abstract required if hired).
- Must be conversant with OHSA regulations and comply with the site Safety plan and rules.

Accommodations:

The project site is a dormitory style accommodations complex with a small gym. Meals are provided, Lunches are bagged style and sit-down meal setting for breakfast and supper. Site room and board is supplied by the employer. There will be a bus stop located in Timmins or Sudbury. The bus will transport employees to and from the mine site.
