Role Details

Operational Readiness Tasks and support Côte Gold personal on-site prior to Commissioning during the Engineering, Procurement and Construction Management (EPCM) phase of the site:

- Support the Côte Gold team on site, and promote a safe work environment for all employees, and Côte Gold visitors.
- Co-ordinate with EPCM H&S staff, and any others to ensure overall site H&S Management Plan requirements are met by Cote Gold Staff and Contractors
- Produce weekly update reports.
- Support the Open Pit Mine operations developing Safe working SOP prior to startup of the open pit and for Preparation for Autonomous haul truck haulage and other mining activities.
- Assist in implementing the new Health & Safety software, and other software.
- Promote a positive H&S culture.
- Other support in preparation for Owners mining and process plant commissioning.
- Review and Update Cote Gold Health and Safety Management Plan for the EPCM phase
- Manage all required Health and Safety Management Plan Administration tasks as required under the current Cote Gold Health and Safety Management Plan.

Commissioning and going forward into production:

- Develop and facilitate the implementation of Health and Safety Management tools (Job Hazard Analysis, Job Task Observation, Incident Declaration forms, Investigation of Accident), ICAM investigations, as well as assisting in developing Health & Safety Programs.
- Initiate cross-training with other departments to improve workflow and streamline the management of risks both at the operational level and in larger scope such as H&S risks.
- Supports other departments in the conception of their policies and procedures.
- Assist in audits of Management System implementation site-wide as well as audits.
- Review and optimize the utilization of H&S software and standardizing Document Control and record management site-wide.
- Support implementation of H&S tools (JTO, JSA) as well as attending departmental safety meetings.
- Conduct daily field inspections, boots in the field. Works with all departments as a resource for health and safety – Surface, Mill and Site services departments.
- May assist with the Emergency Response Team preparedness and other activities.
