Heavy Equipment Operators and Labourers

Summary:

Under the general supervision of the Superintendent and immediate Foreman, the employee shall perform assigned tasks according to regulated health and safety policies and maintain proper communication links with all personnel.

Contract will be on a Term basis as required and with possible extension.

HEO Qualifications:

- Licensed for heavy equipment operation of one or more of the following: Backhoe, Excavator, Bulldozer, Front-End Loader, Grader, Haul Truck, or other heavy equipment, with certification from a recognized institution.
- Ability to operate required equipment in a safe and responsible manner.
- Ensure a sound understanding of the issues involving ground disturbance.
- Ability to conduct pre-operation checks on equipment.
- Knowledge of equipment safety, maintenance, and storage.

Labourer Qualifications:

- Demonstrate knowledge and experience of labouring tasks associated with construction and maintenance.
- Regularly perform Health & Safety inspection of equipment and tools.
- Possess the physical strength, hand-eye coordination, and endurance to complete tasks.

General Qualification (all employees):

- Ability to follow direction and understand scope of work.
- Knowledge of workplace safety requirements and procedures.
- Experience in construction and mining industry, *preferred*.
- Ability to accurately complete all work reports, as required.
- Effective communication.
- Certified WHMIS, or willing to obtain prior to start date.
- Must have completed Ministry of Labour's Health and Safety Awareness in 4-Steps:

Working Conditions:

- Rotation schedule of 2 weeks in/1 weeks out.
